**GREATER NANTICOKE AREA ANNOUNCES
REGISTRATION FOR KINDERGARTEN**

The Greater Nanticoke Area School District will conduct Kindergarten Registration for the 2020-2021 school term on April 6th, 7th and 8th. Times are 9 A.M. to 11 A.M. and 12:30 P.M. to 2 P.M. on each day.

In order to be eligible for Kindergarten next school year, a child must be five (5) years or older on or before September 1, 2020. Parents must accompany their child. Please bring the child's original birth certificate, and provide all *current health and immunization records*. Also two (2) proofs of residency are required. You must also provide a picture I.D. along with the proofs of residency. If a child is a foster child or there is a custody paper, please bring the original so that a copy can be made for the child's record. All information is necessary to complete the registration. All copies will be made at the school.

According to the Department of Health, all children must be immunized with the following in order to attend school: DPT - four (4) or more properly spaced doses with the fourth dose given on or after the 4th birthday; Polio - 4th dose on or after 4th birthday and at least six (6) months after previous dose given; MMR - two (2) properly spaced doses with the first dose on or after the 1st birthday; Hepatitis B - three (3) properly spaced doses of Hepatitis B; Chicken Pox - 2 (two) doses of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine or a history of the disease.

All residents of the Greater Nanticoke Area School District will attend the registration at the Kennedy Early Childhood Center, 513 Kosciuszko Street, Nanticoke.

All children registering for Kindergarten will receive speech, hearing, and vision examinations. A reading readiness screening will also be done on each child.

Registration for new first grade students will also be accepted at this time. In order to be eligible for first grade next school year, a child must be six (6) years of age on or before September 1, 2020. Parents must bring all the necessary information that is required for the kindergarten registration.

Registration packets will be available in the Principal's Office beginning on March 23rd between the hours of 9 A.M. and 2 P.M. in the Principal's office at the Kennedy Early Childhood Center. Parents/Guardians may pick up a packet and complete the information prior to coming to the registration in April. We are hoping that this process will help make registration move smoothly and quickly at registration in April.

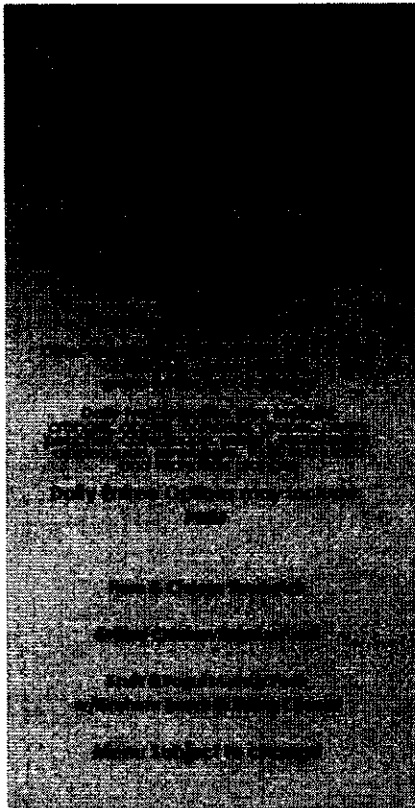
